

APRIL 2008 MINUTES

April 24, 2008

Meeting brought to order at 7:10 by President Robert Marin.

Roger with Kombat Sports had been present at the Executive Board meeting to show the board members different uniforms and he remained on site when the regular board meeting started. He showed samples of what he could offer the club, should WSC decide to change their uniform.

Roger brought Adidas, Nike and Puma samples in Jerseys, Shorts, Socks, Backpacks, Warm up Suits, Bags and Balls.

Various scenarios, along with prices, were given for each brand combination.

The following was decided, by the board, should the club chose to change the uniform this fall....

Rec: Rec teams would have 1 shirt - orange, sock, and shorts (same brand)

Metro: Metro teams would have 2 shirts (white as 2nd shirt), socks and shorts (same brand)

The vote, to change uniforms, would take place later in the meeting, as more people would be present.

I calculated the packages at 40% off and the individual items at 25% off.

After the initial purchase everything defaults to 25% off.

puma pant \$30.75
puma large backpack \$35.75 (available in orange)

The custom balls will be \$6.50 plus tax. Can we get this order in the pipeline?
